Denial of the County Administrator to Execute Verizon South, Inc. Easement Deed  
on County Owned Property at Tax Map 9-A-37D

WHEREAS, the County owns the real property located at 10501 Orange Plank Road, Spotsylvania, Virginia, 22551, designated as Tax Map No. 9-A-37D, located in the Chancellor Magisterial District (the "County Property"); and

WHEREAS, to extend its fiber optic service from Brock Road to the Six Lanes West subdivision, Verizon South, Inc. seeks a permanent utility easement totaling 12,810 square feet, more or less, over the County Property; and

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors has considered Verizon South, Inc.'s request for an easement and has determined that such easement over County Property is not in the best interests of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY SUPERVISORS THAT,

Verizon South, Inc.'s request for an easement over the County's real property located at 10501 Orange Plank Road, Spotsylvania, Virginia, 22551, designated as Tax Map 9-A-37D, is hereby denied.
