**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING CHURCHILL DRIVE BE ADDED TO THE STATE  
SYSTEM OF SECONDARY ROADS**

WHEREAS, Churchill Drive within Waverly Village Section 2D Subdivision located within the Courtland voting district, as described on the attached Additions Form AM-4.3, fully incorporated herein by reference, are shown on plats recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Spotsylvania County, and

WHEREAS, the Resident Engineer for the Virginia Department of Transportation has advised the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors, the streets meet the requirements established by the Street Requirements of the Virginia Department of Transportation,

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors and the Virginia Department of Transportation have entered into a comprehensive agreement on June 6, 1997, for stormwater detention in Spotsylvania County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors requests the Virginia Department of Transportation to add the street(s) described on the attached Additions Form AM-4.3 to the secondary system of state highways, pursuant to Sec. 33.2-705, Code of Virginia, and the Department's Subdivision Street Requirements, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors guarantees a clear and unrestricted right-of-way, as currently described, and any necessary easements for cuts, fills and drainage, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Resident Engineer for the Virginia Department of Transportation.
