Section 64-106 Action on Certain Matters in Election Years

In any year in which members of the Board are elected in a general election, the Board shall not take any action or vote in November or December regarding any of the following types of matters: (1) rezoning applications on which the County is not compelled to act during the relevant time frame pursuant to Virginia law; (2) special use permit applications or conditional use permit applications on which the County is not compelled to act during the relevant time frame pursuant to Virginia law; (3) comprehensive plan amendments; (4) zoning text amendments; (5) land acquisitions, excluding those acquisitions associated with approved projects in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP); (6) borrowing money; (7) appointments to any boards, authorities, commissions, and/or committees; and/or (8) budget amendments, except prior year reappropriations after the County's financial statements are completed and adjustments occasioned by the approval of contracts or the acceptance or implementation of grants.
