**Resolution in Support of Caroline County Special Exception Application # SPEX-01-2015**

**WHEREAS**, Bardon, Inc. has applied for a Special Exception for Sand and Gravel Extraction and Sales in Caroline County on land owned by Fox Spring Farm, LP and located south of U.S. Route 17 under application #SPEX-01-2015; and

**WHEREAS**, the sand and gravel extraction operation would be an extension of the sand and gravel extraction and processing plant operating in Spotsylvania County on Tax Map Parcel 38-A-26A; and

**WHEREAS**, expansion of the extraction area in Caroline County is projected to add approximately 15 years to the life of the operation; and

**WHEREAS**, Bardon, Inc. has operated in Spotsylvania County for over 6 years at this location and has been a good neighbor; and

**WHEREAS**, locally available sand and gravel operations support numerous businesses and economic development in the region and reduces the cost of infrastructure projects through reduced costs associated with the transport of materials.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors does hereby support approval of Caroline County Special Exception application # SPEX-01-2015.
