**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-**

**Approving Grant Application Submission and Designation of Authorized Organizational  
Representatives for the Justice Assistance Grant Opportunity Provided by the Department of  
Criminal Justice Services**

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office is seeking approval to apply for a federal sub-award grant from the Department of Criminal Justice Services in the amount of \$50,000 to be utilized by the Sheriff's Office for a patrol boat; and

WHEREAS, if awarded the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office will need to provide approximately \$32,892 in costs that are not reimbursable by the grant; and

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office identified available funding to meet these additional costs through the resale of an existing retrofitted civilian patrol; and

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office will also provide additional funding through their existing FY 2018 Capital Improvement Project Budget for vehicles; and

WHEREAS, if awarded the County will act as fiscal agent for the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office for the purposes of processing the funding of this grant.
