NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing at **6:00 pm** on **March 27, 2018**, in the Board of Supervisors Meeting Room of the R.E. Holbert Memorial Building, 9104 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, Virginia, to receive public comment on proposed amendment to County Code Chapter 21 – Taxation, Article III – Real Estate Taxes, Division 5 – Real Estate Tax Exemption for Rehabilitated Structures, and to receive public comment on the proposed enactment of a new Division 6 to Article III – Exemption for Surviving Spouses of Certain Emergency Services Providers Killed in the Line of Duty.

The proposed amendment to Division 5 – Real Estate Tax Exemption for Rehabilitated Structures includes the addition of a State Law reference. The proposed enactment of Division 6 provides an exemption from taxation for the qualifying real property of spouses of any law enforcement officer, firefighter, search and rescue personnel, or emergency medical services personnel who are killed in the line of duty.

Persons affected may appear and present their views at the public hearing described above. A copy of the full text of the proposed amendments is on file in the Office of the County Administrator, located at 9104 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, Virginia, 22553, and may be inspected between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

The Board of Supervisors encourages the participation of all interested county citizens. For those with special needs, please notify the County Administrator of any accommodations you may require at least five days before the meeting you wish to attend.
