- ADDS TOWING CERTIFICATION MAINTENANCE REQUIREMENTS;
- ADDS REQUIREMENT THAT EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018, ALL AUTHORIZED TOWERS AND AUTHORIZED HEAVY-DUTY TOWERS REGISTERED WITH THE COUNTY WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND SHRP2 (STRATEGIC HIGHWAY RESEARCH PROGRAM 2) TRAINING (FREE TRAFFIC INCIDENT MANAGEMENT RESPONDER TRAINING BY VIRGINIA STATE POLICE);

AMENDMENTS - CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 232(A)

MINIMUM VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORIZED TOWERS:

- **1 Tow Truck/REGULAR WRECKER**, EQUIPPED WITH A WRECKER CRANE CAPABLE OF LIFTING AT LEAST 7,500 LBS. AND CAPABLE OF TOWING 7,500 – 10K LBS. MUST ALSO HAVE WHEEL LIFT CAPABLE OF LIFTING AT LEAST 1,500 LBS; **AND**



- **1 ROLLBACK**, WITH AT LEAST AN 8,000 LB. WINCH AND A MINIMUM DECK RATING OF 8,000 LBS.



WHY THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE NECESSARY



TOW TRUCK OR REGULAR WRECKER DEFINITION: TRUCK MUST HAVE BEEN

- 1) DESIGNED AND EQUIPPED TO LIFT, PULL OR CARRY ANOTHER VEHICLE BY HOIST OR OTHER MECHANICAL APPARATUS, **AND**
- 2) HAVE A MANUFACTURER'S GVWR OF AT LEAST 10,000 POUNDS.



AMENDMENTS - CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE VII, SECTION 232(B)(1)

MINIMUM VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORIZED HEAVY-DUTY TOWERS:

- 2 HEAVY-DUTY TOWING & RECOVERY TRUCKS; AND
- 1 HEAVY-DUTY ROAD TRACTOR.



ONE SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM 50-TON (100,000 LBS.) ROTATOR, AND THAT UNIT SHALL HAVE WINCHES RATED A MINIMUM OF 40,000 LBS. ANOTHER HEAVY-DUTY TOWING & RECOVERY UNIT SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM 25-TON (50,000 LBS.) FIXED BOOM, AND IT SHALL HAVE WINCHES RATED AT A MINIMUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (25,000) POUNDS. THE TOTAL COMBINED RATING OF THE THREE (3) REQUIRED UNITS IS A MINIMUM OF 75 TONS (150,000 LBS.).

ALL HEAVY-DUTY TOWING & RECOVERY TRUCKS HAVE A MINIMUM TOWING CAPACITY OF 80,000 LBS.


EQUIPMENT/PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS FOR AUTHORIZED HEAVY-DUTY TOWERS:

- HYDRAULIC- OPERATED TRAILER (MIN. 45 FT. LENGTH) CAPABLE OF TRANSPORTING A WRECKED/DISABLED ROAD TRACTOR AND/OR DEBRIS;
- TRAILER/BOX TRAILER; (MIN. 45 FT. LENGTH);
- DUMP TRUCK, DUMP TRAILER OR DUMP CONTAINER;
- SKID STEER LOADER, FORKLIFT OR WHEEL LOADER CAPABLE OF MOVING CARGO AND/OR DEBRIS FROM HIGHWAY; AND
- ADEQUATE PERSONNEL TO OFF-LOAD CARGO.

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MAXIMUM NUMBER
OF TOWERS ON SHERIFF'S TOW ROTATION LIST**

WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors is authorized by Section 46.2-1217 of the Code of Virginia to regulate services rendered pursuant to police towing requests; and


WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the County to limit the fees that may be charged for services rendered pursuant to police towing requests; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2014, the Towing Advisory Board voted to on the limitations below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors this 10th day of June, 2014, adopts the below listed limitations on fees charged for services rendered pursuant to police towing requests:

Light Duty Towing Fees All Rates shown are Maximum Rates	
▶ Basic Police Call - Accident Tow and Clean Up:	\$275.00 (day) \$300.00 (after hours ¹)
This includes, but not limited to, sweeping up and removing glass and vehicle parts from roadway. No charge for mileage within the zone.	
▶ Basic Police Call - Non-Accident Tow:	\$200.00 (day) \$225.00 (after hours)
Defined as a police request tow requiring a vehicle to be towed to the towers storage lot.	
▶ Police Required Second Tow:	\$75.00
Vehicle towed to the Sheriff's Office/VSP, then released back to the tow company to tow back to their lot.	
▶ Disabled Vehicles:	\$150.00 (day) \$175.00 (after hours)

¹ Whenever the term "After Hours," is used herein, it refers to the hours of 5:01p.m. - 7:59 a.m. every day and all day on weekends and holidays.
