

At a meeting of the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors held on October 23, 2018, on a motion by \_\_\_\_\_ and passed \_\_\_\_\_, the Board adopted the following resolution:

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-**

**Designation of Authorized Agents for the Grant Application for the Federal Fiscal Year  
2018 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program**

**WHEREAS**, Spotsylvania County desires to apply for federal grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice under the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2018 State Criminal Alien Assistance Program (SCAAP); and

**WHEREAS**, SCAAP provides federal payments to states and localities that incurred correctional officer salary costs for incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens with at least one felony or two misdemeanor convictions for violations of state or local law, and incarcerated for at least 4 consecutive days during the reporting period; and

**WHEREAS**, the reporting period for the FFY 2018 SCAAP program is from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is not required to provide a local match for the grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, any grant funds that will be awarded will be passed onto the Rappahannock Regional Jail to offset their correctional officer salaries associated with the incarceration of undocumented criminal aliens; and

**WHEREAS**, SCAAP applications must be submitted by a government official of the state or locality with the legal authority to apply on behalf of the governmental entity.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors, that the following individuals are hereby designated as authorized agents any of whom may act in the execution and administration of the grant application: Mark B. Taylor, County Administrator; Mark Cole, Deputy County Administrator; Edward Petrovitch, Deputy County Administrator; Mary Sorrell, Finance Director; and Annette B. D'Alessandro, Grants Manager.
