Approving Grant Award Agreement, Designation of Authorized Agents in the Execution and Administration of the Grant Award and Acceptance and Appropriation of FY 2019 Funds

WHEREAS, Spotsylvania County has applied for and received approval for a state grant from the Virginia Department of Health in the amount of \$5,450 to be utilized by the Sheriff's Office for the purchase of five Lifepak 1000 kits; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors that the grant in the amount of \$5,450 is accepted and that the General Fund budget is hereby amended to reflect the increase in funds associated with the grant award; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors that the following appropriations be, and the same hereby are, made for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, for expenditures in the amount of \$5,450 to be utilized only for the purchase five Lifepak 1000 kits for the Sheriff's Office, to be expended only by order of the Board of Supervisors as follows:
