Persons affected may appear and present their views at the public hearing described above. A copy of the full text of the proposed amendment and a map of the proposed polling place change are on file in the Office of the County Administrator, located at 9104 Courthouse Road, Spotsylvania, Virginia 22553, and may be inspected between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
