WHEREAS, the Department of Justice offers the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant – Local Solicitation and allows local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on their own local needs and conditions, and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , Spotsylvania County is eligible to receive \$28,196 under the FFY 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant – Local Solicitation, and
WHEREAS, the Spotsylvania County Sheriff's Office would like to utilize these funds to purchase a wireless target system for firearms training, and
WHEREAS, the County is not required to provide a local match for the grant award; and
WHEREAS, the equipment costs will exceed the available grant funds; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Sheriff's Office will make up the additional costs through use of their FY 2020 Adopted Budget, asset forfeitures funds, or a combination of these funding sources.
<b>NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED</b> by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors that Spotsylvania County submit a grant application under the FFY 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant – Local Solicitation in the amount of \$28,196; and
<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors, that the authorization to advertise for a Public Hearing on September 10, 2019 is approved; and
<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors, that the following individuals are hereby designated as authorized agents any of whom may act in the execution and submission of the grant application: Ed Petrovitch, County Administrator; Mark Cole, Deputy County Administrator; Mary Sorrell, Director of Finance; and Annette B. D'Alessandro, Grants Manager.
