<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors that the award in the amount of \$95,473 is accepted and that the General Fund and School Technology Fund budgets are hereby amended to reflect the increase in funds associated with the grant award; and
<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> by the Spotsylvania County Board of Supervisors that the following appropriations be, and the same hereby are, made for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, for expenditures in the amount of \$95,473 to be utilized only for expenses associated the implementation of an anonymous reporting system that will enable students, teachers, faculty, and community members to anonymously identify school threats, to be expended only by order of the Board of Supervisors as follows:
